
TEAK MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Teak is one of the most durable and beautiful materials for outdoor use. With proper care, it is easy to maintain, aging naturally into a refined, silvery patina.

Characteristics

- Teak is a dense hardwood with high natural oil content.
- Naturally resistant to rot, insects, and weathering.
- Will gradually develop a silver-gray patina when exposed to the elements.
- Leaching - Surface oils may naturally appear and will fade with use.

Routine Care

- Wash with warm water and a mild dish soap such as Dawn® using a soft-bristle brush along the grain.
- Rinse thoroughly and air dry or towel dry to prevent water spotting.

Deep Cleaning

- For stubborn dirt or weathering, use a teak cleaner:
 - Option A: Star brite® Teak Cleaner & Brightener
 - Option B: Golden Care® Teak Cleaner
- For isolated stains or marks, sand lightly with 120-180 grit sandpaper along the grain, then wipe or rinse clean.

Optional Protection

- Option A: Golden Care® Teak Protector – helps to maintain a golden tone.
- Option B: Semco® Teak Sealer – helps to slow graying with a neutral finish.

Environmental Tips

- In coastal areas, rinse more frequently to remove salt buildup.
- During long non-use periods, store clean and dry furniture using breathable protective covers.
- In wet climates, avoid standing water on teak surfaces.
- In hot, dry climates, teak can dry out more quickly, leading to minor surface cracks. To maintain stability and appearance:
 - Apply a UV-protective teak sealer once or twice per year to retain moisture and reduce weathering.
 - Avoid applying oils, which can attract buildup and mold and can accelerate drying.
 - During extreme heat (100°F+), cover or relocate pieces temporarily if practical to reduce UV stress.

Do's & Don'ts

- Do clean regularly to prevent mildew growth.
- Do test all cleaning products in a small, inconspicuous area before full application.
- Do not power wash teak—it strips oils and damages the wood fibers.
- Do not allow water to pool for extended periods on cushions or tabletops.

ALUMINUM & STAINLESS STEEL MAINTENANCE AND CARE

DANAO aluminum and stainless steel frames combine strength with a marine-grade powder coating system engineered for long-term outdoor exposure.

Characteristics

- Frames are finished with a marine-grade powder coating system, enhanced by a ultra-durable UV-stable topcoat.
- Beneath the surface, an epoxy primer provides the corrosion barrier that gives true marine credibility.
- The combination of primer + ultra-durable finish goes beyond standard powder coatings, delivering long-lasting resistance to salt, sun, and weather.

Routine Care

- Wash with warm water and a mild soap such as Dawn® using a soft cloth or sponge.
- Rinse thoroughly and air dry or towel dry to prevent water spotting.

Deep Cleaning

- For stubborn stains, use a cleaner safe for powder-coated aluminum:
 - Option A: WD-40 Specialist® Cleaner & Degreaser (non-aerosol, water-based)
 - Option B: Simple Green® Extreme Aircraft & Precision Cleaner
- Apply with a soft cloth, rinse thoroughly, and dry.

Optional Protection

- Option A: 303® Aerospace Protectant – adds UV protection and restores color depth with a uniform satin finish.
- Option B: Flitz® Ceramic Sealant Spray – darkens and enriches the finish while creating a hydrophobic barrier against water spots.

Environmental Tips

- In coastal areas, rinse frames weekly with fresh water to remove salt buildup.

Do's & Don'ts

- Remove standing water after heavy rainfall.

Deep Cleaning

- Option A: StoneTech® Revitalizer Cleaner & Protector
- Option B: Weiman® Granite & Stone Cleaner
- Always follow product directions and rinse surfaces thoroughly.

Recommended Protection

- Option B: StoneTech® BulletProof Sealer
- Always test in a small, inconspicuous area before full application.

Environmental Tips

- Use coasters, placemats, or trays to protect against spills and acidic foods.

- Option A: 303® Multi-Surface Cleaner
- Option B: Star brite® Mildew Stain Remover (use with caution – test first and rinse immediately)

Characteristics

- Batyline (PVC-coated polyester mesh): Flexible, breathable, quick-drying, and dimensionally stable; resists sagging and mildew. Green Gold Certified.
- Synthetic Fiber (HDPE wicker): UV-stable, weatherproof, durable alternative to natural fibers.
- All are resistant to fading, cracking, and stretching under normal outdoor conditions.

Routine Care (All Materials)

- Rinse with fresh water to remove loose debris.
- Wash with warm water and a mild soap such as Dawn® dish soap using a soft cloth or soft-bristle brush.
- Rinse thoroughly and allow to air dry.

Deep Cleaning (All Materials)

- Highly durable against abrasion and hydrolysis.
- Resists mildew and staining.
- Resists heat buildup when exposed to direct sunlight.

Routine Care

- Wipe regularly with warm water and a mild soap such as Dawn® dish soap using a soft cloth.
- Rinse with clean water and air dry.

Deep Cleaning

- For stubborn stains, use 70% isopropyl alcohol on a soft cloth, then rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- For sanitizing, wipe with Clorox® Healthcare Bleach Germicidal Wipes, followed by a clean water rinse.
- Always test in a small, inconspicuous area before treating large surfaces.

Optional Protection

- Not recommended: do not use protection sprays, conditioners, or coatings which will interfere with polyurethane performance.

Environmental Tips

- In coastal or humid regions, wipe surfaces more frequently to prevent buildup of salt or organic matter.
- During long non-use periods, store clean and dry furniture using breathable protective covers.

Do's & Don'ts

- Do not soak or saturate seams.
- Do not use waxes, polishes, or leather conditioners.
- Do rinse thoroughly after using alcohol or bleach wipes.

FABRIC

Characteristics

- All DANAO fabrics are 100% solution-dyed acrylic or polypropylene.
- Fade-resistant, breathable, and mildew-resistant.
- Bleach-cleanable without loss of color.

Routine Care

- Vacuum or leaf blow loose debris regularly.
- Hose off with fresh water and air dry.
- Spot clean with warm water and a mild soap such as Dawn® dish soap using a soft brush.
- Foam inserts do not need to be removed for routine care.

Deep Cleaning

- Machine wash removable covers on gentle cycle, cold to warm water (up to 40°C / 104°F) with Tide® Free & Gentle or a similar neutral detergent.
- For mildew or mold: wash using a bleach solution (up to 1 cup bleach per gallon water) plus mild soap.
- For stains: Option A: 303® Multi-Surface Cleaner; Option B: OxiClean® Versatile Stain Remover.
- Rinse thoroughly and air dry. Do not tumble dry.

Optional Protection

- Option A: 303® Fabric Guard – helps to restore water repellency.
- Option B: Star brite® Waterproofing Spray.

Environmental Tips

- Increase cleaning frequency in humid or coastal climates to reduce mold/mildew risk.
- During long non-use periods, store clean and dry furniture using breathable protective covers.

Do's & Don'ts

- Do not use fabric softeners.
- Do not dry covers in a dryer—air dry only.
- Do fit covers back onto cushions while slightly damp to maintain shape.
- Do test all cleaning products in a small, inconspicuous area before full application.

FOAM INSERTS

Characteristics

- High-resiliency foam cores are enclosed in a waterproof yet breathable SMS fabric liner.
- The SMS liner prevents water from penetrating the foam while allowing air circulation.
- Outer fabric covers are water-repellent but not waterproof – water may pass through, but the foam core remains protected.

Routine Care

- No special care is required for the foam insert.
- All cleaning and maintenance should be directed to the fabric cover.

Optional Protection

- For best long-term protection, use DANAO Protective Covers when furniture is not in use.

Environmental Tips

- During long non-use periods, store clean and dry furniture using breathable protective covers.

Do's & Don'ts

- Do not machine wash foam inserts or liners.
- Do not pressure wash cushions.
- Do inspect liners occasionally to ensure integrity.

PROTECTIVE COVERS MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Protective covers extend the life of your furniture by shielding it from dust, debris, and the elements when not in use.

Characteristics

- Made from solution-dyed polyester (such as SurLast®), designed for strength, UV resistance, and breathability.
- Lightweight yet durable for long-term outdoor exposure.

Routine Care

- Wash with warm water and a mild soap such as Dawn® dish soap using a soft cloth or sponge.
- Rinse thoroughly and allow to air dry before reuse.

Deep Cleaning

- For stubborn dirt: Option A: 303® Multi-Surface Cleaner; Option B: Simple Green® Outdoor Furniture Cleaner.
- For mildew or heavy staining: prepare a diluted bleach solution (maximum 1 cup bleach per gallon water with mild soap).
- Lightly apply to the fabric face side (non-coated side) only. Do not soak.
- Allow no more than 2 minutes of contact, then rinse thoroughly and immediately with clean water.
- After bleach use, restore water repellency with 303® Fabric Guard.

Optional Protection

- Option A: 303® Fabric Guard – maintains water repellency.
- Option B: Star brite® Waterproofing Spray.

Environmental Tips

- Ensure covers are fully dry before storing to prevent trapped moisture.
- Use breathable covers to reduce the risk of mold or mildew underneath.

Do's & Don'ts

- Do not machine wash or tumble dry covers.
- Do not use harsh solvents or abrasive cleaners.
- Do not allow bleach solutions to sit longer than 2 minutes.
- Do rinse thoroughly after any bleach treatment.
- Do reapply repellency treatment after bleach use.
- Do test all cleaning products in a small, inconspicuous area before full application.

Covers tearing, abnormal fading, and foam failure

- Excludes: Normal wear and cushion compression

Terms

- Valid from date of shipment; original purchaser only
- DANAO's liability is limited to the original purchase price
- Photos or inspection may be required to evaluate claims

Not Covered

- Misuse, abuse, neglect
- Unauthorized modifications
- COM (Customer's Own Material) items
- Damage from excessive wind, freeze, or improper storage
- Packaging or shipping costs unless pre-approved
